Nomination Form

Criteria

The Police Heritage Museum hopes to recognize a well-rounded law enforcement officer who has exceeded the duty requirements expected of his/her position and has also demonstrated a distinct pattern of community service along with professional achievement. Selection criteria will include:

- Significant achievements that go above and beyond the call of duty
- Outstanding acts of kindness or compassion or courage
- Consistency in day-to-day operations
- How the officer represents his/her agency and profession
- Community work the officer performs in his/her own time
- Performs in a manner, which reflects the highest standards of the profession

Law enforcement agencies may only nominate **ONE (1)** law enforcement officer from their department, unless prior approval is received from the Police Heritage Museum, Inc. to submit more than one nominee. The Police Heritage Museum, Inc. will only approve such requests when provided with compelling evidence to do so.

The Law Enforcement Officer of the Year Award is not awarded for a specific incident, but rather for a pattern of service and achievement. Narratives describing a specific act or incident may be rejected or reclassified.

Presentation of Award

All nominees shall be recognized at the awards ceremony. Nominees not selected to receive the Law Enforcement Officer of the Year Award shall receive an appropriate certificate and/or award.

The Law Enforcement Officer of the Year will receive a personalized award. The officer's name will be placed on a permanent plaque to be displayed at the Police Heritage Museum site, and a plaque will be provided to the officer's agency for display at its offices. A donation of \$1,000 will be made to the Police Heritage Museum by MediaOnePA in the name of the award recipient.

In the case of a posthumous award, the award will be made in the name of the officer to a surviving spouse, child, or parents of such officer.

The awards ceremony is a televised event, and photographers will be present. Please contact the Police Heritage Museum in advance if officers are nominated that cannot be photographed, so alternate arrangements can be made.

Nominations must be postmarked or received no later than **APRIL 5, 2010**.
